Assembly of Procession

- Floats or vehicles must be assembled by 8:30am
- **NO** vehicles will be allowed in the assembly area after this time
- Marchers are to assemble in the allocated areas by 9:00am

NO Floats or vehicles will be allowed in the RNA Showgrounds. Please make arrangements to **immediately** remove vehicles and floats at the end of the march to wherever you are going to park.
